

**Key Findings**

- Student enrollment has declined from 5,277 in 1993-94 to 4,972 in 2007-08. State and regional enrollment has increased during this period (see Exhibit 4).
- LEP enrollment has declined from 963 in 1993-94 to 405 in 2007-08. State and regional enrollment has increased during this period (see Exhibit 5).
- LEPs served in the Bilingual/ESL program has declined from 738 in 1993-94 to 307 in 2007-08. State and regional enrollment has increased during this period (see Exhibit 6).
